- 1. ASL Timelines
 - Explanation: How to show past, present, and future in ASL, using space
 - Visualizing time
 - Past: Behind the signer
 - Present: Neutral space in front
 - Future: Forward movement
 - Practice sentences
 - "Yesterday, I ate Pizza."
 - "Tomorrow, we will go to church."
- 2. Numbers 100-999,999
 - Explanation: How to sign three-digit and larger numbers
 - Examples
 - 100: Index finger forms "1," followed by "C" handshape.
 - 1,000: Sign "1," followed by the sign for "thousand" (flat hand tap).
 - Larger numbers: Combine digits logically (e.g. "999,999").
- 3. ASL Etiquette
 - Getting Attention
 - Tapping shoulder, waving, or using vibration to gain someone's attention respectfully
 - Taking Turns
 - Using pauses, head nods, or signing "hold on" to signal conversational turns
