1. Time Vocabulary
 - Using ASL to express time concepts:
 - Specific times (e.g. hours, minutes)
 - Frequency (e.g. “always,” “never,” “sometimes”)
 - Days of the week and related activities (e.g. “on Monday, I will...”)
 - Practice signing questions and statements involving time:
 - “What time is it?”
 - “I work on Monday.”
2. Sentence Structure
 - Combine previously learned vocabulary with time-related terms.
 - Practice sentences like:
 - “Yesterday, I read a book.”
 - “On Sunday, I go to church.”
