Week 7: School, Weather, Professions, and Classifier Use

Student Handout

Topics:

1. Classifier 1:

- Definition: Represents thin, upright objects (e.g. person standing, a pole, a pencil)
- Examples:
 - Using Classifier 1 to describe motion: "A person walking," "a line of people."
 - Indicating directions or paths: "The car drove past a person."

2. Silent Dinner:

- Purpose: Introduce students to Deaf cultural events like Silent Dinners, where communication is done only in ASL.
- Date and time announcement
- Guidelines: No spoken words. Focus on ASL fluency, and observe Deaf culture.
